What is SUPER SEEDTREAT?

SUPER SEEDTREAT is a seed coating applied pre-plant to assist seed germination and early growth, particularly in zinc and/or manganese deficient soils.

What are the benefits of using SUPER SEEDTREAT?

SUPER SEEDTREAT supplies essential micronutrients during germination and the critical weeks after, providing significant improvement in seedling vigour and tillering.

SUPER SEEDTREAT has proven to increase root mass by up to 150%.

SUPER SEEDTREAT contains high levels of Zinc and Manganese that are made available to the seed on root and shoot emergence, which reduces the severity of plant diseases such as Rhizoctonia and Take All.

SUPER SEEDTREAT will result in stronger healthier plants that are better able to withstand disease and seasonal stresses, consistently giving increased yields.

What else do I need to know about SUPER SEEDTREAT?

SUPER SEEDTREAT can be readily applied by seed dressing machines. Small quantities of cleaned seed can be coated by mixing thoroughly by hand, or in concrete mixer. Larger quantities can be effectively coated through an auger.

SUPER SEEDTREAT treated seed can be stored for periods up to 1 year.
